

Hello Carnell Families,

The SDP has launched a plan to ensure all students have access to digital learning opportunities in the event that schools remain closed long-term due to COVID-19 response effort.

We are excited to be able to participate in the Chromebook loaner program to ensure all of our students will have access to online materials during the school closure. Thank you to all of the families that participated in the technology survey on class DOJO, and the families that called in and texted their need for Chromebooks. This information helped us to get an idea of how many families are in need of technology.

We have a limited amount of Chromebooks to distribute so if you have a smart phone, computer, laptop, tablet, or smart tv, in your home, we are asking that your children use those devices. If your child or children does not have access to any devices at home, we are asking that you follow our instructions to receive a loaner device.

In an effort to ensure the safety of everyone, we ask that you follow the directions. We want to have minimal people on-site, so we ask that only the parent or legal guardian come to pick up the Chromebook. Children are advised, if possible, to stay at home. We want this process to be safe and quick therefore keep minimal conversation.

The Chromebook device distribution will be hosted at 9:30 am on Thursday, April 9th and will be a “walk-up” service. Parents or legal guardians must adhere to the following steps:

Bring a form of photo ID to verify that you are the parent or legal guardian (government-issued ID, student ID, Work ID).

Please park your cars on the street and not in the parking lot

We will distribute Chromebooks from the auditorium located in our school Yard. Please line up 6 feet apart from each other at door A.

A School Police Officer will greet you when you reach the front of the line at door A.

The School Police Officer will direct you

A greeter from inside the school will ask you to show your photo ID and verify the name of the student(s) for which you are picking up the device. We will also ask you for your Cell phone number and advise you via text messaging when to proceed to the pickup

station. The Pick up station will be located at Door B on the other side of the auditorium.

At the pickup area, there will be a table with the loaner agreement for you to sign.

A greeter wearing proactive gloves/mask will come out to the table and ask you to place the signed form in a bin.

We will review the signed form and a staff member will place your Chromebook on the table for you to pick up.

Please be reminded that this is a loaner program to ensure all students will have access to online materials during the school closure for students who do not have any technology at home. There is no cost for this program and no obligation to participate. All devices will be expected to be returned at the conclusion of the school closure period.

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
